



TX UM Gift Exchange

During the Meet & Greet event, your contestant will get to exchange fun good luck goodies with their age division. Each contestant is required to bring an inexpensive little goody for the girls in their group. These should be thoughtful and useful for competition days. For example, nut-free snacks, make-up wipes, or chocolate! Each gift should be tagged with the contestant's name and division. You can also include a message and photo.

Remember: do not give anything that could be a choking hazard for the younger contestants and do not include anything with nuts or other allergens. You only have to bring gifts for your contestants age division. The exact number of girls will be given following the pageant deadline. Have fun with this!!!

1. **Freelance Contestant \$500**

-Contestant has never competed in a UM event. Eligible for any official placement/title except Ambassador. Includes all required competitions, contestant packet and badge, 1 chaperone badge, 1 program book, entry into all State events for contestant and chaperone, 1 "Good Luck" bag, 1 commemorative contestant t-shirt, 1 entry for Director's Choice (0-6) or Contestant's Choice (7+).

2. **State Contestant \$400**

-Contestant has competed in UM Nationals, State, Regional or Preliminary competition. Eligible for any official placement/title except Ambassador. Includes all required competitions, contestant packet and badge, 1 chaperone badge, 1 program book, entry into all State events for contestant and chaperone, 1 "Good Luck" bag, 1 commemorative contestant t-shirt, 1 entry for Director's Choice (0-6) or Contestant's Choice (7+).

3. **Ambassador Program \$300**

-All-Abilities Contestant may or may not have competed in any UM event. Eligible for Ambassador title only. Includes all required competitions, contestant packet and badge, 1 chaperone badge, 1 program book, entry into all State events for contestant and chaperone, 1 "Good Luck" bag, 1 commemorative contestant t-shirt.

4. **Protégé Program \$200**

-Contestant has competed in UM Nationals, State, Regional or Preliminary competition. Not eligible for any official placement/title, PRACTICE ONLY. Includes all required competitions, contestant packet and badge, 1 chaperone badge, 1 program book, entry into all State events for contestant and chaperone, 1 "Good Luck" bag, 1 commemorative contestant t-shirt, 1 entry for Director's Choice (0-6) or Contestant's Choice (7+).

5. **Optional Only Contestant \$100**

Competition Guidelines - Ages 0-6 Years

We stress individuality when selecting your wardrobe. Makeup is allowed, however application must be age appropriate.

Modeling Formation: High fashion modeling is allowed. Showing your personality on stage is encouraged. Have fun with your time on stage!

→Formal Wear: Formal dress

0-6 years: short length, strapless not allowed

Dresses showing the midriff are not allowed for any age. All should be age appropriate.

Judging will be based on facial beauty, stage presence, and poise. Contestants are not judged for the type of dress they are wearing but how well it compliments their style and personality as well as the fit of the garment.

→Open Fashion

All contestants will model a professional pant, short, or skirt outfit or a dress (not a formal pageant dress) of their personal style. Have fun with this competition! Note: Open Fashion can be as simple or as high fashion as you like. Halloween type costumes not allowed.

Judging based on facial beauty, stage presence, and poise. Contestants are not judged for the type of outfit they are wearing but how well it compliments their style and personality as well as the fit of the garment.

→Interview

Age-appropriate Sunday's Best/Tailored Dress (Not a formal pageant dress). A skirt/jacket combo or a pant outfit can also be worn.

Universal Baby division - Contestants will have an escort who will introduce the contestant to the judges and will be given this time to share a few fun facts about the contestant. Baby contestants will be judged on their overall appearance, their behavior, and personality.

Universal Mini Division - Contestants will meet with their panel of judge's one-on-one, will introduce themselves, and will be given a series of age appropriate questions by the appointed moderator. Judging will be based on the contestant's confidence, poise, overall appearance, ability to answer the questions given, and personality. Example questions: Who is your best friend? What is your favorite holiday? What is your favorite food?

→Meet & Greet

Texas UM T-Shirt (provided at registration) to be paired with bottoms of any style. Dressy shoes not recommended. All contestants in these two divisions will be in a play setting with the other contestants in their age division. This will be tons of fun for our littles! One chaperone **MUST** accompany the contestant. Judges will walk around while the contestants are playing! Contestants will sign songs, play age-appropriate games, and show the judges their personality off the stage. Contestants will receive their program book and bring their goody bag gift for their division to distribute.

→Finals

Universal Baby & Mini: Top 10 finalists will recompete by modeling FORMAL WEAR. Top 5 will do a collective judge.

Universal Mini ONLY: Following Top 10 remodeling, a Top 5 will be chosen. Those selected for Top 5 will remain in their FORMAL WEAR and compete in an on-stage interview competition. This will include a single Q & A session between the contestant and emcee. This will be a conversation with age-appropriate questions similar to those asked in interview.

Competition Guidelines - Ages 7+ Years

We stress individuality when selecting your wardrobe. Makeup is allowed, however application must be age appropriate.

Modeling Formation: High fashion modeling is allowed. Showing your personality on stage is encouraged. Have fun with your time on stage!

→Formal Wear: Formal dress

7-9 years: short or long length, strapless not allowed (If wearing long dress, slits cannot be above knee.)

10-12 years: long length, strapless not allowed (Slits cannot be above knee.)

13+ years: long length, strapless allowed

Dresses showing the midriff are not allowed for any age. All should be age appropriate.

Judging will be based on facial beauty, stage presence, and poise. Contestants are not judged for the type of dress they are wearing but how well it compliments their style and personality as well as the fit of the garment.

→Open Fashion

All contestants will model a professional pant, short, or skirt outfit or a dress (not a formal pageant dress) of their personal style. Have fun with this competition! Note: Open Fashion can be as simple or as high fashion as you like. Halloween type costumes not allowed. All should be age-appropriate.

Judging based on facial beauty, stage presence, and poise. Contestants are not judged for the type of outfit they are wearing but how well it compliments their style and personality as well as the fit of the garment.

→Interview

Age-appropriate professional interview tailored dress or business suit (skirt and pants allowed). All should be age appropriate.

Contestants will meet with their panel of judge's one-on-one, will introduce themselves, and will be given a series of questions by the appointed moderator. Judging will be based on the contestant's confidence, poise, overall appearance, ability to answer the questions given, and personality. Political and religious questions will NOT be given.

→Personal Introduction

Texas UM T-Shirt (provided at registration) to be paired with bottoms of your choosing. No regulation on shoes. Contestants will have 45 seconds to introduce themselves on stage in front of the judges and the audience by saying their name, state, and something interesting about themselves and/or their future goals. Embrace You and be proud to share how amazing and unique you are! Judging will be based on execution, content, and personality. Note: any introduction going over the time limit will receive a deduction.

→Meet & Greet

Very casual, wear your everyday clothing. Judges are NOT allowed. Yoga pants or shorts and t-shirts are great. All contestants in these divisions will be able to enjoy getting to know her fellow contestants by meeting their division team leader and completing team building activities. Contestants will receive their program book and bring their goody bag gift for their division to distribute. Judges will NOT be present at Meet & Greet.

→Finals

Universal Baby & Mini: Top 10 finalists will recompete by modeling FORMAL WEAR. Top 5 will do a collective judge.

Universal Mini ONLY: Following Top 10 remodeling, a Top 5 will be chosen. Those selected for Top 5 will remain in their FORMAL WEAR and compete in an on-stage interview competition. This will include a single Q & A session between the contestant and emcee. This will be a conversation with age-appropriate questions similar to those asked in interview.

Rules and Regulations - All Ages

COVID-19– the health and safety of our contestants, employees, families, and friends is our top priority. We are diligently monitoring the Coronavirus/COVID-19 and closely watching official information from health authorities, such as the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), as it relates to our events, and competitions. All contestants and their chaperones/guests must sign an Assumption of the Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19 before participating/attending the State competition.

By participating in this competition, each contestant agrees that all decisions by the judges will be final; questions concerning comments on the score sheet will be allowed, however scores and judges decisions will remain final. Judges' scores/comments will be released to each contestant at the end of State finals.

Flash photography is not permitted in the staging area! All contestants, chaperones, guests/family members, directors, and staff grants permission to Universal Miss and its affiliates, designees, agents, licensees, and invitees to use the image, likeness, actions and statements of the attendee in any live or recorded audio, video, film, or photographic display or other transmission, exhibition, publication, or reproduction made of, or at, the event in any medium, whether now known or hereafter created, or context for any purpose, including commercial or promotional purposes, without further authorization or compensation.

Any unruly, aggressive, inappropriate, or belligerent behavior by contestants, chaperones, or spectators will result in potential contestant disqualification, removal from the event and/or barred participation from future UM Events with the possibility of suspension for following years.

Any contestant that does not adhere to the terms and procedures of this contestant manual will be subject to disqualification from the competition and will automatically forfeit any right to any prizes or awards presented by the competition. Disqualification from the State competition is a serious matter. If a contestant is disqualified, she will not be eligible for a refund.

Contestants and their chaperones should display professional manners, including good sportsmanship, before, during, and after competition. If you do not agree with the judge's decision you may contact us following competition and an executive staff member will be happy to assist in answering all your questions/concerns.

If a contestant is late and misses her place in line, she will be added to the back of the line-up for that event and a 1 point deduction will be given per judge. If a contestant misses the event in its entirety, they will be scored a zero in all areas of judging for the event missed.

All participants, chaperones and guests MUST observe housing rules and curfews imposed by the pageant.

Smoking is only permitted in the designated smoking areas.

Contestant must be a naturally born female. Contestant must be a citizen or legal resident of the United States.

All pageant fees are non-transferable, non-refundable. There is a Forty-Five Dollar (\$45) fee assessed for any returned check.

Interview

All contestants WILL go through a short interview session. UM interview allows the judges to get one-on-one time with each contestant. There will be a moderator asking age-appropriate questions to each contestant. Each contestant will come in one at a time. Stand on the X placed in front of the judge's table.

Contestants ages 0-2 years will come into the room with their escort. The escort will be directed to say the contestant's name and age. Then the escort will be directed by the moderator to give a short introduction about the contestant. The escort should tell the judges some fun facts about the contestant. The moderator will NOT give questions to this group.


Contestants ages 3+ years will begin by introducing themselves by saying their name and age, followed by the moderator's questions. Once the contestant's questions are done, they will be directed to exit the room. At that point, their interview session will be completed.

Example Questions-

Age divisions Universal Mini- Universal Young Miss: What is your favorite holiday? Where is your favorite place to go out and eat? What is your favorite school subject or what game do you like to play outside?

Age Divisions Universal Preteen- Teen: What after school activities are you involved in? What do you plan on becoming when you grow up? What is your favorite book? What do you enjoy doing on the weekends?

Age Divisions Universal Miss-Universal Elite Miss: What are some things that help you destress? Where do you see yourself in the next decade? What is makes you special? How can you help mentor the youth?




Program Book

Modeling Guidelines

At UM we want to see your personality during your time on stage. Relax, be yourself and shine on the stage! All contestants will have a 45 second time limit. You do not have to use the entire 45 seconds, but a red light will be flashed when your time on stage is up. You will be required to exit the stage when the red light is seen. There will be a chance for contestants to practice on stage before competition starts. Our staff will work with each contestant to make sure they know exactly what to expect before judged competition.

X's will NOT be placed on the stage.



Note: This is an example of the National Universal Miss stage. Due to room size and riser availability, understand it may be smaller/different at State. This does provide a guide to entrance and exit locations as well as general set up.

Scoring Guide: Finals

Round 1

All ages: The top ten contestants from the preliminary round will have the opportunity to win an additional 50 points that will be added to their preliminary score during finals. These 50 points are broken down into the following weighted subcategories:

<u>Formal Wear (re-compete) (all ages)</u>	<u>Points Possible</u>
Facial Beauty/Overall Look	10 points
Outfit/Grooming	10 points

Personality	10 points

At this stage the 0-2 age division final results will be announced based off of highest scores. All other division will compete in one additional round.

Round 2

In this final round the top five contestants in each division will participate in a final question and answer session with the emcee which will award a possible 50 points to their previous score. These 50 points are broken down into the following weighted subcategories:

In the event of a tie, the judges will review scoring from all competitions and make a decision based on the contestant's scoring and over-all impression on the judges. Due to time constraints, on-stage questions may be removed.

UNIVERSAL MODEL \$15 EACH (LIMIT 5)

Multiple outfit categories will be offered for your contestant that loves the stage. Judging based on stage presence, modeling proficiency, poise, confidence, outfit choice and fit, and overall appearance. Judging system: point system. Contestants entering 5 or more categories that receive a Platinum score on any one of the 5 or more entered will qualify for the Universal Model Showdown Competition. Each outfit modeled will have the opportunity to score the max. of 100 points.

Participants will receive a Custom UM Medallion for each entry.

PRACTICE INTERVIEW \$20

Contestant will go through a mock interview session. Comments will be given back to help prepare contestants for the real event. All receive a small gift.

So much fun!

BELLA MISS \$50

Practice pageant. Contestants will model one formal dress. Judging based on facial beauty, stage presence/poise, confidence, personality, and dress fit. Winner in each division will receive a Custom Texas UM Tiara or Crown & Banner



BABY/MINI TALENT \$20 EACH

Does your little one love performing? Let her shine during this optional talent competition. Those in the baby division must be accompanied by an adult for security purposes. Participants will receive a Custom UM Medallion for each talent.

PERSONAL ESSAY \$20

Does your contestant have a gift of writing? If so, showcase her writing by submitting a personal essay to be judged with other contestant's submissions. Each year a topic will be given in the contestant manual. Submissions should be a minimum of 3 paragraphs, but no longer than 1 page in length. The winning essay will be printed in the program book. Essay MUST be written by the contestant!

Winners (7-12 & 13+) will receive a Custom UM Medallion and essay printed in program book.

UNIVERSAL ENTERTAINER \$30 EACH (LIMIT 3)

Multiple talent categories will be offered for your contestant that loves to perform. Judging based on stage presence/performance, ability/technique, choreography, musicality, and overall entertainment value. Judging system: point system. Contestants entering 3 or more categories that receive a Platinum score and any one of the 3 or more will qualify for the Universal Entertainer Showdown competition. Each talent performed will have the opportunity to score the max. of 100 points.

Participants will receive a Custom UM Medallion for each entry.



PRETTIEST & BESTS \$15 EACH

Prettiest Eyes, Prettiest Hair, Prettiest Smile, Best Formal Wear, Best Open Fashion, Best Headshot, & Best Portfolio

These will be judged per division and one winner per category will be selected.

Winners in each division will receive a Custom UM Plaque.

UNIVERSAL PHOTOGENIC \$50 EACH

Photo will be judged on personality, beauty, grooming, fashion sense, and confidence.

Winners in each division will receive a Custom UM Banner and Tiara.

UNIVERSAL SPOKESPERSON \$20

Delegates must deliver a speech no longer than 60 seconds.

Winners (7-12 & 13+) will receive a Custom UM Plaque.

CONTESTANTS CHOICE/DIRECTORS CHOICE \$0

Contestants in the Young Miss through Elite Miss divisions will be able to vote for the contestant in their division that has the best attitude, sportsmanship, and team spirit. The contestant with the most votes will be awarded. Director will choose one chaperone/contestant from the Baby and Mini divisions to award.

Winners in each division will receive a Custom UM Plaque.

Texas UM State Queen Requirements

Under contract State Winners must abide by the following rules/regulations:

1. Must compete at the 2022 Universal Miss Nationals Competition in Orlando, Florida from July 17th through July 23rd.
2. Must maintain a professional reputation on all social media platforms during the duration of her reign. In fitting with the standards maintained by UM, parents of State Winners must do the same.
3. Must maintain the quality of the robe. Every divisional winner will receive a robe as part of the winner's package. This robe is only their property for one year. At the end of their reign, it will be passed down to the new divisional winner. If a robe is not kept in the same condition it was received, understanding natural wear over the year will happen, a fee will be assessed to fix or replace if the damage is irreversible.
4. Must maintain a professional appearance at all times for all events related to UM. This includes hair, make-up, and clothing.
5. Must participate in Universal Miss Service Day activities, July 9rd, 2022.
6. Must attend State finals for the following state season, if applicable. Housing, passes, and remaining scholarship will be given to all divisional winners completing their yearly reign. Invited and encouraged to attend any Texas Regional competition throughout their reign as possible. Remember the more you put into your reign the more you get out of it. State winners must wear company colors when attending any state or local competitions.

Texas UM does NOT have a non-compete clause. However, we will require that you discuss participation in other systems with the Texas State Director PRIOR to entering. We encourage divisional winners to participate in all the Texas UM events that they possible can (Regional competitions, royalty events, etc.). We hope to work together to make your year as our Texas UM Royalty special! We want to help you grow as individuals, experience new and exciting things, and make friends to last a lifetime!!!

Texas UM Ambassador Requirements

Under contract Ambassadors must abide by the following rules/regulations:

1. Must maintain a professional reputation on all social media platforms during the duration of her reign. In fitting with the standards maintained by UM, parents of State Winners must do the same.
2. Must maintain a professional appearance at all times for all events related to UM. This includes hair, make-up, and clothing.
